大会主席广品法师致词要点

1. 2024 年对佛总而言，是充满感恩与奋进的一年。不论在弘扬佛法、提倡教育、社会公益等方面不忘初心地更上一层楼，更在 6 月间选举第 38 届理事会时，引进了 8 位资历深厚的新理事以助会务的稳健与持续发展。
2. 作为佛教社群的年度盛事，本会在 2024 年 5 月 12 日于新加坡博览中心举办以“同体互慈 · 人和世平”为主题的盛大卫塞节庆典，并邀请到我国总统尚达曼阁下及夫人为大会主宾。
3. 2024 年 8 月 24 日，本会在会所礼堂举办第 38 届理事会就职典礼。21 位理事在国会议长谢健平先生的见证下宣誓就职并获颁委任状。谢健平议长也在就职典礼上颁发委任状给两位名誉会长，即：净森法师和陈春金医生。
4. 在普及佛教教育方面，经新任理事会检讨和整编的中英文不同层次的成人佛教班在 2024 年推出。同时也为在籍中小学生续办周日学校，以及举办佛学讲座与佛学营。
5. 在延续传统节日方面，本会在农历新年期间举办了除夕祈福、新春团拜，以及参与人民协会主办的妆艺大游行。

6. 本会的团体会员绝大多数是以社团形式注册，其中许多也同时注册为慈善团体。为提升它们的相关法律的认识和监管水平，本会在 2024 年间开办了一系列的讲座与培训班，包括：了解社团法令、修改社团的章程、社团的不动产与信托人、社团执行秘书培训班。
7. 本会创办和管理的两所学校，致力于为国家培养德智体群美五育俱全的好公民。它们在 2024 年不论的会考成绩有优异表现，也在课程辅助活动的各项校际比赛中傲有人成绩。以会考成绩为例，菩提的小六学生在 2024 年的小学离校考试中再次取得 100% 的及格率的辉煌成绩。文殊中学 2024 年“0”水准至少 5 科及格率达 89.9%。

1. Year 2024 is a year of gratitude and progress. We have made significant progress in areas of Dharma propagation, advancement of education and promotion social welfare centred around our original objectives. Additionally, the induction of 8 highly qualified new Council Members during the election of the 38<sup>th</sup> Term Council has enabled the Federation to achieve stable and sustainable growth.
2. Vesak is the most significant annual event to the Buddhist community. On 12 May 2024, we hosted a large-scaled Vesak Day Celebration at the Singapore Expo with the the theme of “Mutual Compassion, Peaceful World”. HE Mr Tharman Shamugamratnam was the Guest-of-Honour for this gala event with the company of his wife Ms Jane Ttogi.
3. The Installation Ceremony of the 38<sup>th</sup> Term Council was held on 24 August 2024 at SBF Hall with Mr Seah Kian Peng, the Speaker of Singapore Parliament, as the Guest-of-Honour. Witnessed by Mr Seah, all 21 Council Members were sworn-in and presented with Certificates of Appointment. Two Honorary Presidents were presented with Certificates of Appointment by Mr Seah, there are Ven Sek Ching Sum and Dr Tan Choon Kim.

4. In the area of promoting Buddhist education, the newly revised and revamped syllabus for various Dharma courses initiated by the new Council have been launched in 2024. Sunday School for students primary and secondary school, as well as Talks on Buddhism and Buddhist camps continued their operations in 2024.
5. Observation and participation in traditional festive events, such as CNY Eve Blessing Ceremony, CNY Get-together and Chingay Parade, continued to be SBF annual events.
6. As Institutional Members are overwhelmingly registered as societies with significant number of them are also registered charities, we have conducted a series of talks and training courses to acquaint them with the relevant legislations and to assist them to raise their level of governance. Topics of these talks include understanding the Societies Act, Amendment of Constitution, Immovable Properties and Trustees, Training Course for Executive Secretary.
7. The 2 Schools founded and managed by SBF strive to groom all-rounded and good citizens for the nation. They have performed excellently both in academic examinations and CCAs. Take academic performance as an example, Maha Bodhi School has, once again, achieved 100% passes at PSLE 2024, while Manjussri Secondary School has 89.9% of its students achieved at least 5 'O' subjects passed at 'O' Level Examinations 2024.
