2. 2026 学年中一学校分配

在 2026 学年中一的学校分配中，共有 235 名学生被分派至文殊中学就读，编成 7 个班级。其中，84% 的学生在择校志愿中将文殊中学列为第一或第二选择。来自附属学校的学生占本届新生总人数的 30.1%，其中来自菩提学校的学生 67 人 (28.5%)，来自弥陀小学的学生 6 人 (2.6%)。本届新生的主要生源小学为菩提学校、光华学校及友诺小学。

5. 全国考试

2025 年 GCE N 水准会考

本校考生在本次考试中取得良好成绩，中四普通学术课程学生在今年的 N 水准会考中取得显著的增值成果：至少五科及格率达 88.8%，其中 72.5% 的学生符合升读中五课程的资格。按 EMB3 总分指标计算，这也是本校中四普通学术课程学生连续第十年取得增值成果。

2025 年 GCE O 水准会考

本校谨此祝贺学生在本届会考中取得更优异的表现。以 L1B5 及 L1B4 总积分指标计算，本校中四快捷课程及中五普通学术课程学生均取得了良好的增值成果。中四学生的整体成绩超出预期，并为过去五年来最为优异的一届。

整体而言，92.5% 的快捷课程考生符合报读理工学院课程的资格；其中，74.6% 符合报读初级学院或励仁高中普通教育证书高级水准课程的资格。与此同时，82.6% 的普通源流考生也符合申请本地理工学院文凭课程的资格。

在中四快捷课程方面，及格率有所提升的科目包括：美术、数学、高级数学、物理、化学、生物、设计与工艺、人文科（社会科与历史）、科学（物理、化学）以及会计学原理。其中，共有六个科目取得 100% 及格率，分别是：高级华文、马来文、设计与工艺、物理、化学和生物。

中五普通学术课程方面，取得增值成果的科目包括：美术、设计与工艺、营养与食品科学、人文科（社会科与历史）、综合科学（物理、化学）以及会计学原理。

6. 活动与亮点

文殊中学持续提供多元化的课程，以确保学生培养 21 世纪技能。

2026 年第一学期亮点

中一迎新活动 (2026 年 1 月 2 日至 6 日)

2026 年中一迎新活动由学生理事会、课程辅助活动 (CCA) 代表及班级领袖共同组织并执行。在迎新活动期间，新生们深入了解学校的历史与文化，同时熟悉学校的各项支援系统与课程。通过“学长学姐的分享”和“与级任老师共进早餐”等活动，中一新生不仅与老师建立联系，也与同学们建立了新的友谊。

学校见面会 (2026 年 1 月 10 日)

学校于 1 月 10 日举办“学校见面会” (Meet The School)，以促进积极正向的家校合作关系。活动中，学校向家长概述了多项重点校本计划，并分享了有关全面科目编班及个性化数码学习计划等方面的重要资讯。此外，学校也安排教师与家长进行交流，以增进双方对彼此期望的了解，并共同商讨学生的发展方向。今年，学校亦特别于露天剧场为中一家长举行课外活动展示，让家长更深入地了解学校丰富多元的课外活动项目。

文殊探索周 (2026 年 1 月 26 日至 30 日)

文殊探索周是学校的重要学习体验之一，旨在为文殊学生提供走出课堂课程框架、拓展学习视野的机会。活动期间，学生通过多元化的学习体验促进个人成长与发展：中一及中三学生分别在新加坡洛阳公务员俱乐部及义顺的义顺战备军人协会俱乐部举行的户外奇营 (OAC) 中培养自我韧性与品格；中二学生则通过 SAGE 计划学习重要的生活技能、建立自信，并探索升学路径。通过参与这一系列活动，文殊学生得以在学习与实践不断成长，发展成为充满学习热忱、富有同理心的未来领袖。

文殊家长支援小组迎新茶会 (2026 年 1 月 31 日)

文殊家长支援小组 (PSG) 于 1 月 31 日举办迎新茶会，向家长介绍家长支援小组执委会成员，并了解小组各项活动的概况。家长们也有机会与学校领导互动，并参与亲子互动活动，包括通过 Kahoot 测验加深对学校的认识，以及一起制作农历新年装饰品。家长们都十分投入并享受此次活动，珍惜与孩子及学校大家庭共度的美好时光。

爱心礼篮活动 (2026 年 2 月 6 日) 及农历新年庆祝活动 (2026 年 2 月 16 日)

文殊学子精心布置课室，并准备爱心礼篮和贺卡，作为农历新年庆祝活动的一部分送往 4S 活跃乐龄活动中心。学校也邀请该乐龄活动中心的年长者一同参与庆祝活动，并欣赏华乐团、舞蹈团、武术团和合唱团带来的表演。

年度农历新年爱心礼篮活动是我校的特色项目，旨在透过实践学习支持学生发展成为具社会责任感的公民。文殊大家庭成员自愿捐赠食品和日用品，并由中二学生于 2 月 6 日将精心包装的爱心礼篮分送给居住在本校社区伙伴 4S 活跃乐龄活动中心登记住户中的有需要年长者，以表达关怀与祝福。

全民防卫日 (2026 年 2 月 13 日)

全面防卫日旨在提醒学生，保卫新加坡是全体国民共同肩负的责任。当天上午，本校制服团体代表以特别的列队仪式为活动揭开序幕。2 月 12 日，学校参与了“Exercise SG Ready 2026”，即一项模拟数码连接中断情境的演练，旨在帮助学生为潜在的数码基础设施中断做好准备，并提升学校整体的应变能力。活动中，学生也在“粮食韧性展区”接触并认识可食用昆虫，从而加深对粮食安全与危机应对的理解。

2. SECONDARY ONE POSTING EXERCISE AY2026

235 students were posted to Manjusri Secondary School for the 2026 academic year. They make up 7 classes in total. 84% of them made MJR their first or second choice in their school preference. Students from affiliated schools form 30.1% of the intake (Maha Bodhi School – 67 students / 28.5%, Mee Toh School – 6 students / 2.6%). Top feeder schools were Maha Bodhi School, Kong Hwa School and Telok Kurau Primary.

5. NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS

2025 GCE N-Level Examinations

The school congratulates our candidates on achieving good academic outcomes. The school is proud to share that our Sec 4 Normal (Academic) classes have achieved value-added results with 88.8% pass in at least 5 N-Level subjects, and 72.5% of them eligible for Sec 5. Based on EMB3 aggregate measures, this marked the 10th successive year of value-added results for our Sec 4 N(A) students.

88.8% of our Normal (Academic) students obtained five or more subject passes (inclusive of O-level subjects). The overall result is an improvement from previous cohorts' performance.

Four subjects attained 100% pass, including English Language, Design & Technology, Nutrition and Food Science, and Art.

In the Normal (Technical) course, 60.6% of students achieved five or more subject passes. This was an improvement from previous cohorts' performance. Three subjects attained 100% pass, including Basic Malay, Design and Technology and Nutrition and Food Science.

2025 GCE O-LEVEL EXAMINATIONS

The school congratulates our students for their improved outcomes in their examinations. Based on aggregate measures of L1B5 and L1B4 scores respectively, the school is pleased to have achieved value added results in both the Sec 4 Express and Sec 5 Normal courses. The Sec 4 results were above expectations and the strongest of the past five years.

Overall, 92.5% of our Express course candidates qualify for Polytechnic courses; and 74.6% for 'A' level studies at Junior Colleges or Millennia Institute. 82.6% of our Normal stream candidates are also eligible to apply for diploma courses at local Polytechnics.

Subjects which showed an improvement in percentage passes for the Secondary Four Express cohort include Art, Maths, A Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Design and Technology, Humanities (SS, History), Science (Physics, Chemistry) and Principles of Accounts. Six subjects attained 100% passes including Higher Chinese, Malay Language, Design and Technology, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

The Secondary Five Normal cohort attained value-added results in subjects like Art, Design and Technology, Nutrition and Food Science, Humanities (SS, History), Combined Science (Physics, Chemistry) and Principles of Account,

6. PROGRAMMES AND HIGHLIGHTS

Manjusri Sec continues to provide a wide range of programmes to ensure that her students develop 21st century competencies.

2026 Term 1 Highlights

Secondary One Orientation (SOO) Programme (2-6 January 2026)

The 2026 SOO was organised and run by our Student Councillors, CCA and Class Leaders. During the SOO, the students were introduced to the history and culture of our school, as well as various support systems and programmes. Through activities such as Senior-Junior sharing and breakfast with their Form Teachers, the Secondary One students got to know their teachers and formed new friendships with their peers.

Meet the School Session (10 January 2026)

The school organised a Meet-The-School (MTS) session on 10 January for parents/guardians of Secondary One students to Secondary Five students to build a positive Home-School partnership. During the session, the school provided an overview of our key school programmes and shared useful information on areas such as Full Subject-Based Banding and the school's Personalised Digital Learning Programme. The event also featured teacher-parent interactions to allow them to understand each other's expectations and discuss development plans for the respective students. This year, the school organised a CCA Showcase at the amphitheatre for the parents of the Secondary One students.

MJR Discovery Week (26 – 30 January 2026)

MJR Discovery Week is a key school experience where Manjusrians are provided opportunities to be exposed to learning beyond the confines of the classroom curriculum. From developing self-resilience and character in the Sec 1 and 3 Outdoor Adventure Camps (OAC) held at Civil Service Club @ Loyang and SAFRA Yishun respectively; to acquiring important life skills, building up confidence and navigating post-secondary pathways for Sec 2 students through Project SAGE, Manjusrians participated in a variety of activities that enabled them to learn and develop themselves as passionate learners and compassionate leaders.

MJR PSG Welcome Tea (31 January 2026)

The Manjusri Parent Support Group (PSG) organised a Welcome Tea session on 31 January, where parents were introduced to the PSG EXCO team, given an overview of PSG activities. They also had the opportunity to engage with school leaders and participate in parent-child bonding activities, including a Kahoot quiz that tested their knowledge of the school and making Chinese New Year decorations. The parents enjoyed the session, cherishing the time spent with their children and the school community.

Hamper Project (6 February 2026) & Chinese New Year Celebrations (16 February 2026)

Manjusrians decorated their classrooms, and prepared hampers and cards which were delivered to 4S Eldercare Centre @ Eunos Crescent as part of our Chinese New Year Celebrations. Seniors from 4S Eldercare Centre @ Eunos Crescent were invited to join in the celebrations, where they were treated to performances by our Chinese Orchestra, Dance, Wushu and Choir.

The annual Chinese New Year (CNY) Hamper Project is our school's signature programme to provide learning opportunities to support students' development as socially responsible citizens. Members of the Manjusri family made voluntary donations of food and toiletry items which were packed into hampers and distributed by our Secondary Two students on 6 February, to the needy and elderly living in households registered with 4S Eldercare Centre @ Eunos Crescent, our community partner.

Total Defence Day (13 February 2026)

Total Defence Day serves to remind our students of the importance of our collective responsibility in defending Singapore. Our uniform group representatives started the day in the morning with a special procession. On 12 February, the school participated in "Exercise SG Ready 2026", a simulated digital connectivity disruption exercise designed and were even introduced to edible insects at the Food Resilience Booth to prepare our students for potential disruptions to digital infrastructure and enhance our school's resilience.

44th School Anniversary & Award Presentation Day (2 April 2026)
